Define the decision
Identify stakeholders
Create a safe space for discussion
Choose a facilitator



1 COLLECT VIEWPOINTS

Gather relevant data and perspectives Express your viewpoint with I phrases Give everyone the opportunity to speak Avoid direct comments or reponses to others Ask for clarification when needed Specify response time



2 SEEK ALTERNATIVE PERSPECTIVES

Encourage participants to share new ideas or solutions Ask if anyone has a completely different opinion or idea



3 SPREAD THE ALTERNATIVE

Avoid excluding anyone Ask who recognizes elements of minority ideas Inquire about disagreements and alternative proposals Move to a vote if a clear

proposal emerges



A INCORPORATE WISDOM OF The Minority

Engage with those who didn't win the vote

Acknowledge their loss and ask for their input

Include their suggestions in final decision

Conduct another vote after incorporating their perspective
